### 1. Election of Chair

**Resolved** – that Councillor Sadaqat Ali Khan be elected Chairman for the ensuing year and signed his Declaration of Office as Chair

### 2. Election of Vice Chair

Nominations for the Vice Chairman of the Council have been received for Councillor Javed Khan and Councillor Imran Younas.

Councillor Imran Younas withdrew his nomination.

**Resolved** – that Councillor Javed Khan be elected as Vice Chairman for the ensuing year.

### 3. To receive Chair's Welcome

Councillor Sadaqat Ali Khan chaired the meeting and welcomed the Councillors to the meeting.

### 4. To receive apologies for absence

Councillor Shahzada Meer - Ripley

The clerk explained that all the above Cllrs have sent in their apologies.

**Resolved** – All the apologies were received and accepted by the Council.

### 5. To receive disclosures of personal and prejudicial interest from members on matters to be considered at the meeting

### 6. To approve the minutes of the 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024 as a true and accurate record

### 8. To receive Feedback from Ward Councillors

Councillor Taj Salaam provided feedback of various issues affecting residents of the Community Council Wards. These included franchising the bus service, general Elections and the creation of an energy centre in the city Centre.

### **9. To receive Finance report from RFO**

The Finance officer presented a report and advised the Council that the Bank Balance at the end of April was £25,345.29 and we have a potential Surplus at the end of the financial year.

**Resolved** – The report was received by the Council.

### **10. To approve Internal Audit Yorkshire to carry out our Internal Audit**

The Clerk advised the Council that Town Parish Audit had discontinued providing services for an Internal Audit and the clerk had found a company called Internal Audit Yorkshire to carry out the audit.

**Resolved** – It was resolved that Internal Audit Yorkshire would carry out the Internal Audit for the year 2023-24

### **11. To Discuss Correspondence received**

- **Email from Circus Starr**

The clerk informed the Council an email was received from Circus Starr requesting a donation for Vulnerable children to attend a circus Show.

**Resolved:** It was decided as the organisation had many sponsors listed on their website and the email does not clarify if the children will be from the Bradford Trident area we were unable to make a donation this year. The Clerk to contact Circus Starr to inform them and also advise to apply to LEAP.

- **Email from YLCA**

The clerk informed the Council an email was received from YLCA saying that they have partnered with a company called Aubergine to offer a gov.uk website to Parish Councils.

**Resolved:** It was decided as the clerk would look further into this and see if the council were eligible to apply.

### **12. To appoint YLCA Branch Representatives**

The clerk informed the meeting that the council could elect two members of the Council to become the YLCA branch representatives.

**Resolved:** It was resolved that Councillors Mohammed Boota and Javed Khan would be YLCA Branch representatives for the Council.
